### **Sunday Football / Tennis**

This was launched 3 years ago by our very own President Mineshbhai for the Hindu Community of Bolton. Our very first session had about 7 children, and forward on to today we have nearly 60 kids registered, and a team of 8 coaching volunteers. The program is run every Sunday from 10am-11am, on the 3G Pitch at the Westhoughton Leisure Centre.

Participant ages range from as young as 3years Old to 17years Old. We have a mixture of Boys, and over 10 girls registered. Over the years a number of them have developed and joined local leagues as well. In the Winter period we also take the younger kids indoors, whereby we put on a mixed activity of Tennis and Football, led by qualified coaches.

In the 3 years we have been running this program, player numbers have grown, number of coaches have grown, we have entered the kids into tournaments, taken them on away day trips to professional matches. The kids love the sessions as it allows them to make friends within the community, and given there is no pressure as its all purely for fun, means they leave with smiles and fun memories.


